On Tuesday, December 23, 2010, City officials, project associates and G.E. Johnson celebrated Topping Out of the Lone Tree Arts Center by signing their John Hancock and then placing an 8600 pound structural beam at the future lobby area.

Earlier in December, G.E. Johnson completed the Mainstage Theatre steel placement which included the highest point of the facility reaching 58' 0" high. Overall, over 380 tons of steel and over 1800 cubic yards of concrete have been used to build the facility. December progress includes:

- All masonry wall installation is complete;
- Structural Steel placement is underway and complete at the Theatre and Multi-purpose Room;
- Metal roof decking is being placed;
